**S**tanley Brooks Jr quietly passed away on May 29, 2023 in Pahala. He was born March 2, 1950 to Emma Kealiiholokahiki Martinson and Stanley C Brooks Sr both of Ka'u. He was the youngest of seven, he is survived by Sisters : Margery (Hansen) of Kona, Mona Emiko (Ishibashi) of Hilo, Mary "Lani" (Best) of Keaukaha and Stalma Lauae (Makuakane) of Na'alehu, Brothers: Raymond Fujikawa of Na'alehu and Riley Fujikawa of Honolulu.

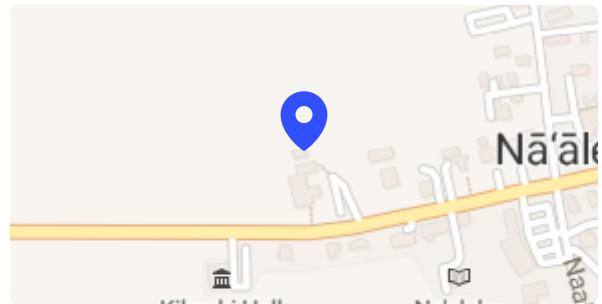

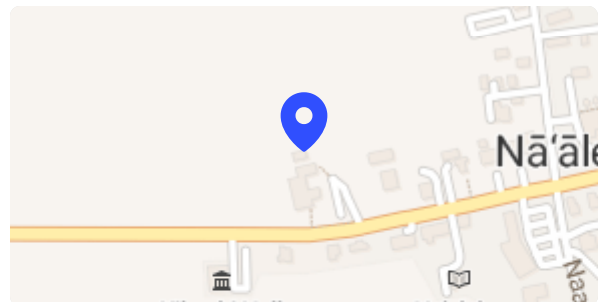

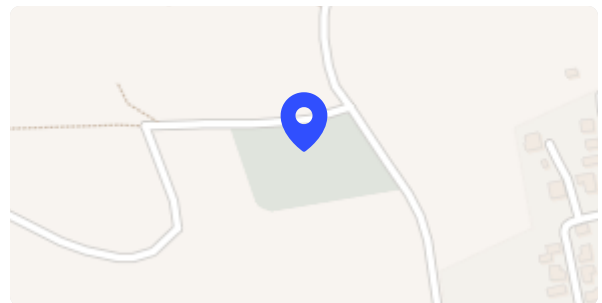
