Chastity Melissa Baucom (Chas), age 47, formerly of Hilo, Hawaii, passed away peacefully at home on Monday, September 25, 2023. She died of natural causes.

She was a graduate of Hilo High School's Class of 1993. She continued her education at UH Hilo and majored in Political Science. She was a real people person who had a great passion for music and dance, so much so that she landed a position at Tempo Music. Chastity had a long history of employment here in the city of Hilo. At the early age of 10 years old, she delivered newspapers for the Tribune-Herald. While still in High School, she worked at Hiro's Restaurant after school as a fry cook and cashier. To list a few employers here in Hilo: Wamart as Direct Receiving Associate, Home Depot as an accounting associate, YMCA as an outreach worker for children and families in the community, and Pancro Collections as a collector. Her last and final employment was with Hawaii County Economic Opportunity Council as a Medical Transportation Specialist. There she stayed for many years until early retirement due to illness.

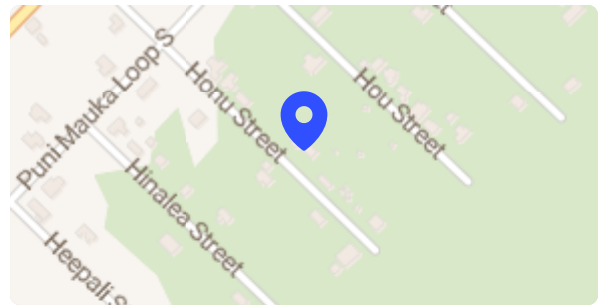
