Military honors will take place on Friday March 1st , 2024, 8:30am at the Veterans Cemetery II 110 Laimana st Hilo Hawaii 96720



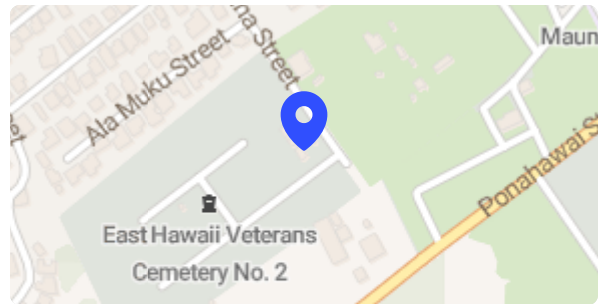

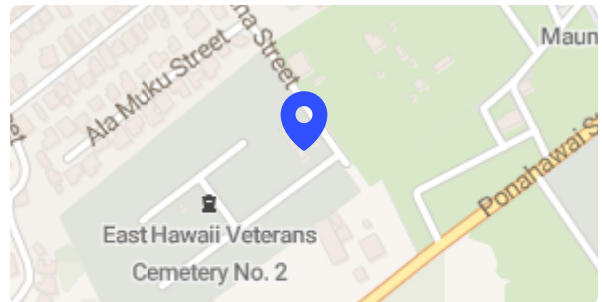
