Dr. Carl Frederick Oguss died at home in Kea'au, Hawaii on January 29, 2026. He was 69 years old. Dr. Oguss was born in Far Rockaway, New York to parents Murray Oguss and Louise Kirn Oguss. He is survived by siblings Fran Oguss Stallings, David Oguss, Emily Oguss Robertson and Ken Oguss.
